What you need before we start

To take part in the practical exercises you'll need to sign up to Flourish

- Account with Flourish: <https://app.flourish.studio/register> (You can log in with your Google account if you want to)

You don't need a paid account - the free one is very functional.

It's also very useful, but not essential, if you have access to Excel or another spreadsheet programme, for viewing the data.

For the two practical exercises we're using some real data found on the London Datastore, as part of the [Mayor of London's Economic Fairness](#) dataset. The data looks at the number and proportion of people earning below the London Living Wage.
