# User needs stories (internal example)

**As a <type of user>** – <u>Who</u> are you? What's your role?

**I need <some data>** – <u>What</u> do you need to know?

**So that <some reason>** – <u>Why</u> do you need to know it? What are you intending to do with this knowledge?

As a Support Worker who organises the food bank deliveries

**I need** to be able to produce a list of beneficiaries and their requirements for each ward in the borough

**So that** I know what & how much is needed for each ward to prepare parcels and map the addresses for the delivery drivers

### **Create a custom dataset**

We group Census 2021 data together based on who or what the information is about, for example, people or households. We make population types from these groups or subsets of them. For example, people who are usually resident in England or Wales make up the population type usual residents. <u>Read about</u> the measurements we used for Census 2021 data.

Select population type



Either one usual resident living alone or a group of people who share cooking and living facilities, where that group includes at least one usual resident.

The overall Index of Multiple Deprivation 2019 is a measure of multiple deprivation based on combining together seven distinct domains of deprivation. Income Deprivation. Employment Deprivation, Education, Skills and Training Deprivation. Health Deprivation and Disability. Crime. Barriers to Housing and Services. Living Environment Deprivation.

### **Getting Started with Geo Mapping** Top tools for visualising postcode data on a map

padlet

<u>Padlet</u> probably not known for mapping! There is a map padlet option enabling you to add posts and content to points on a map. Great for participatory crowd sourcing maps with communities.



**Batchgeo** is an easy to use point map creator. Copy and paste postcodes from Excel, along with up to 7 other pieces of data (optional), and visualise points on the map (colour coded by category accordingly). Share via a link or embed on your website. Nice 'limit Zoom' option for data privacy. <u>See our step by step guide</u>.



<u>Google MyMaps</u> allows you to plot point data as well as bounday shapes e.g. boroughs or wards. Add a maximum of 10 layers which can be visible or hidden, and contain points or shape files. There's also a good range of design customisation options and ability to add multi media. <u>See our step by step guide</u>.
