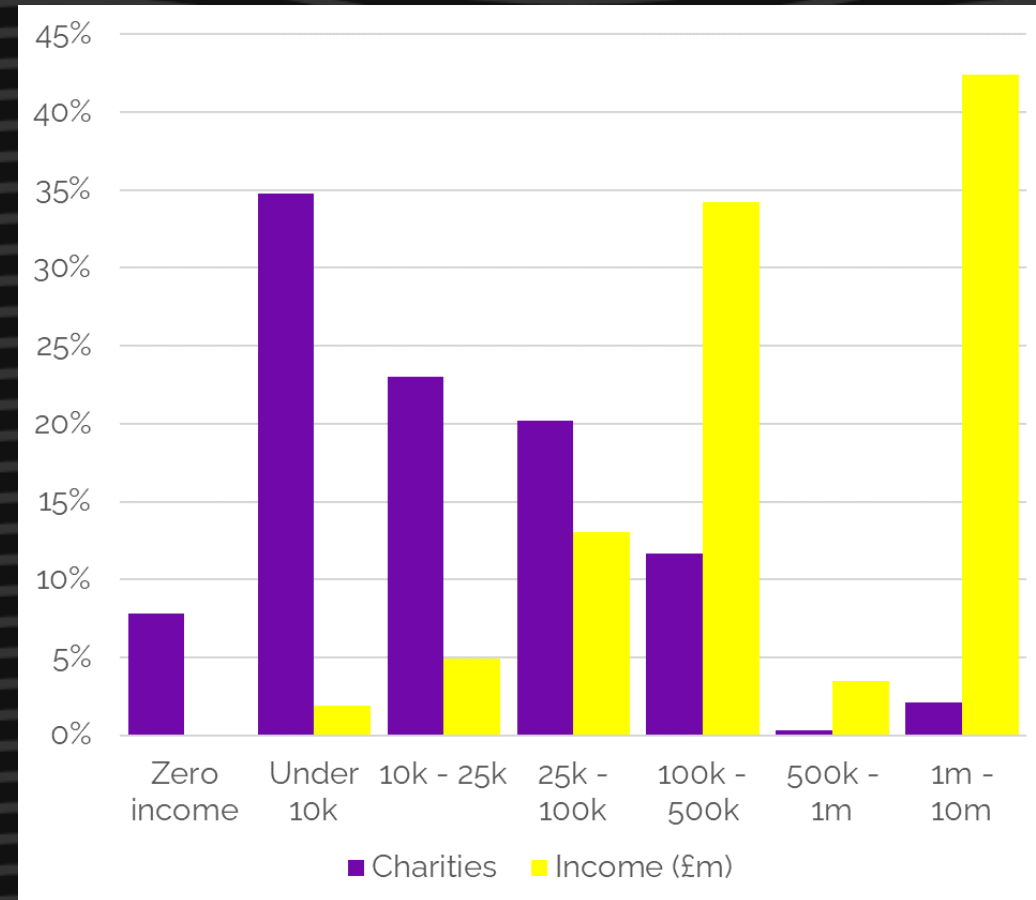

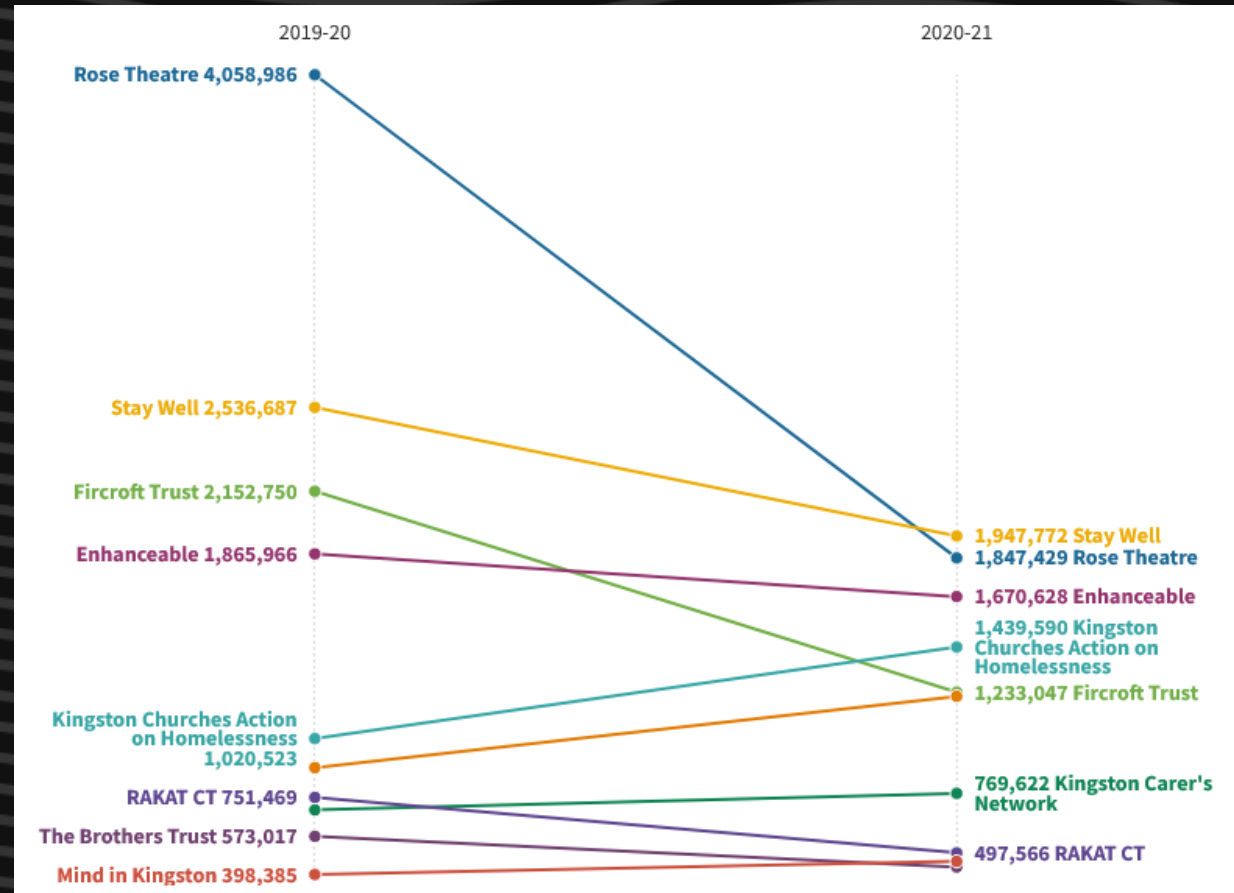

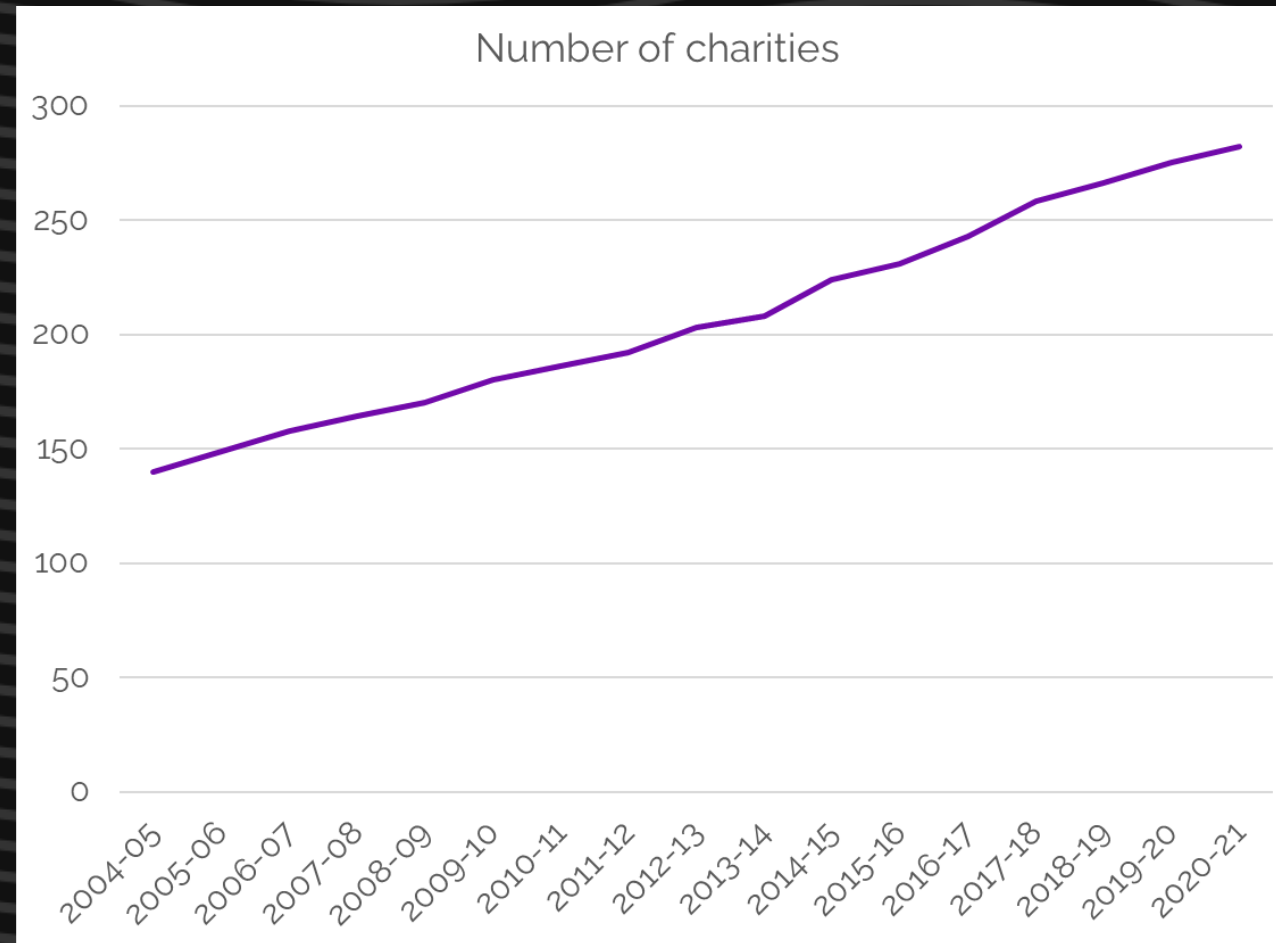

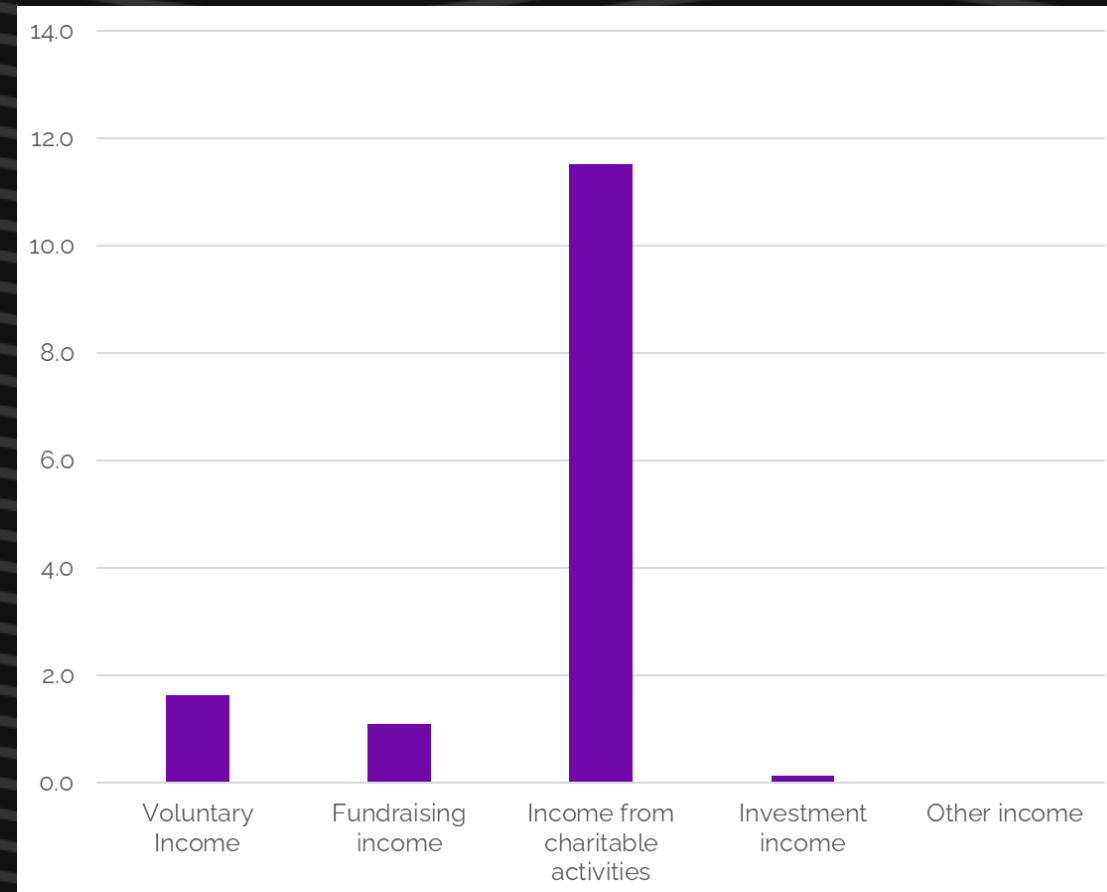
\*\* It's not mandatory to report volunteer numbers to the Charity Commission, and they are often estimates – that's why the number is very different to last time

\*\*\* actually represents trustee positions – some people may be a trustee of more than one charity



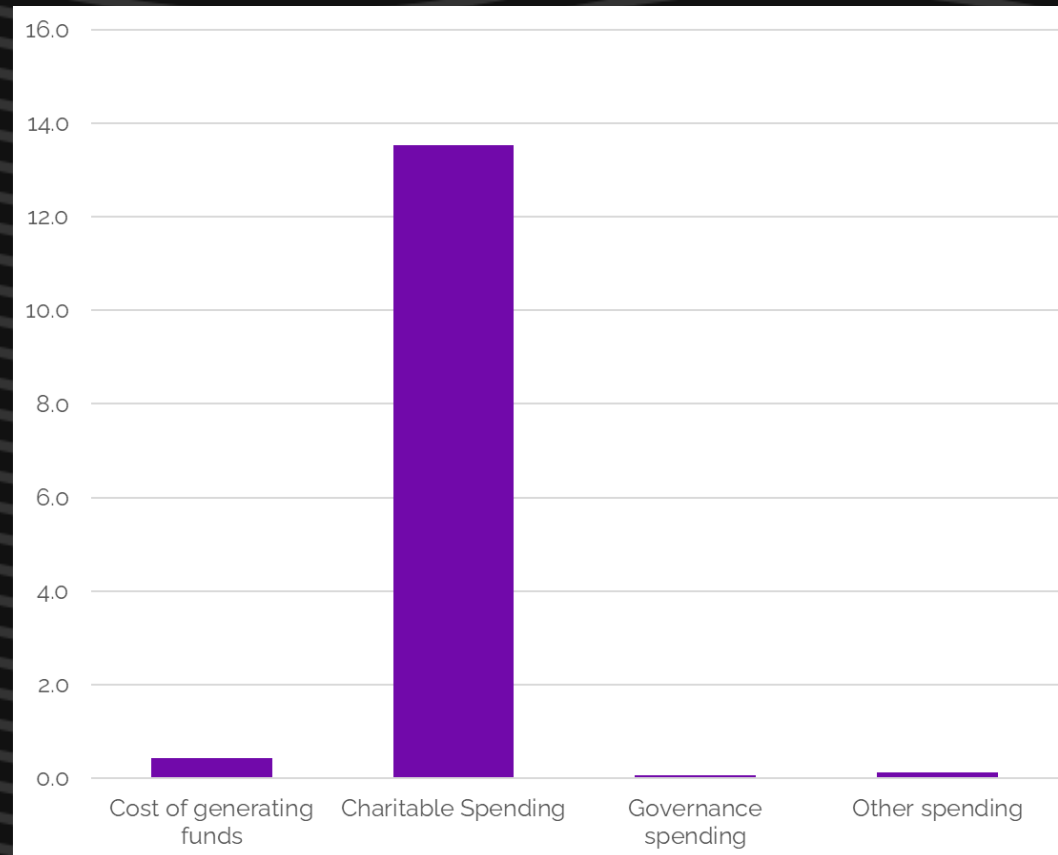
# Type of income

# Type of spending

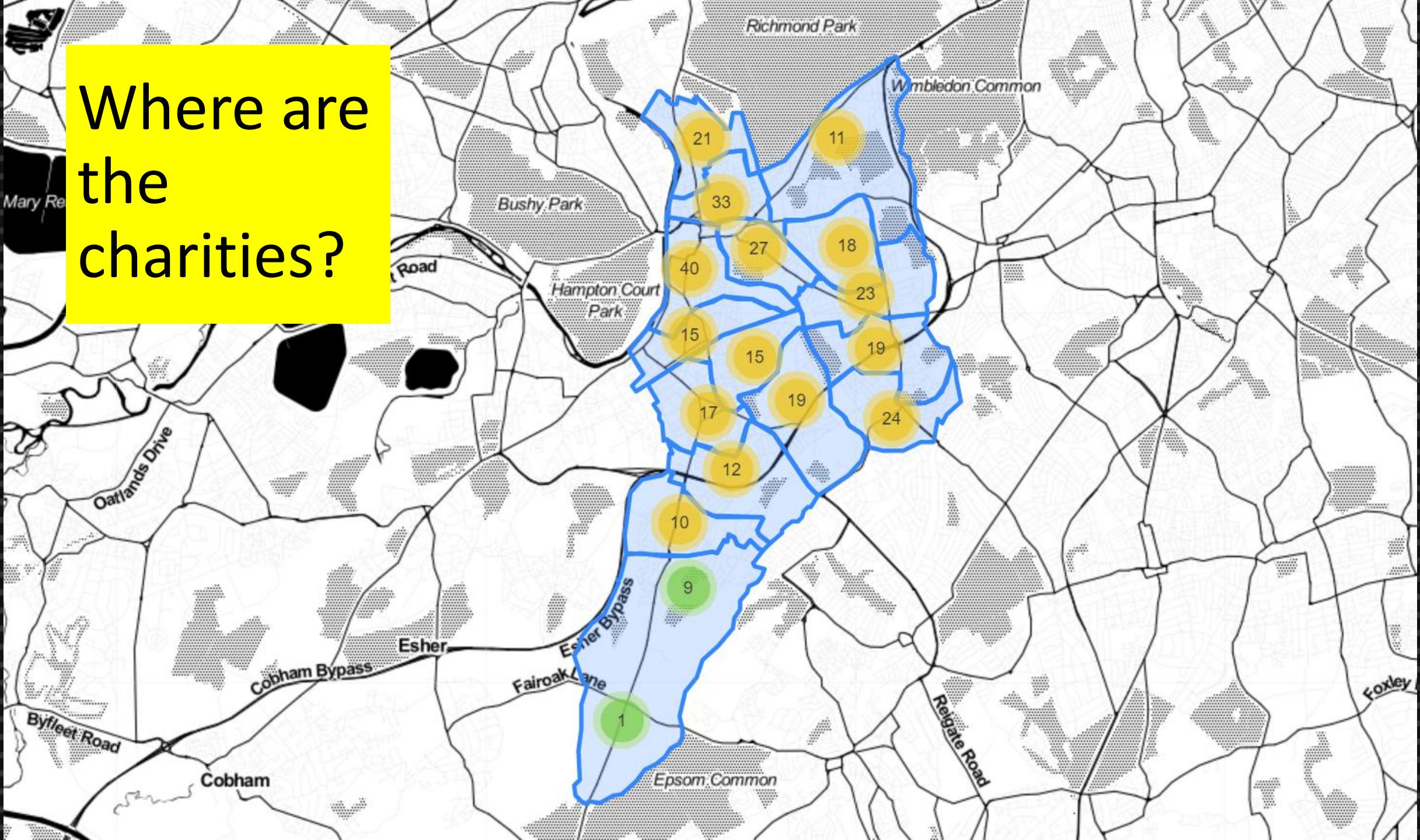

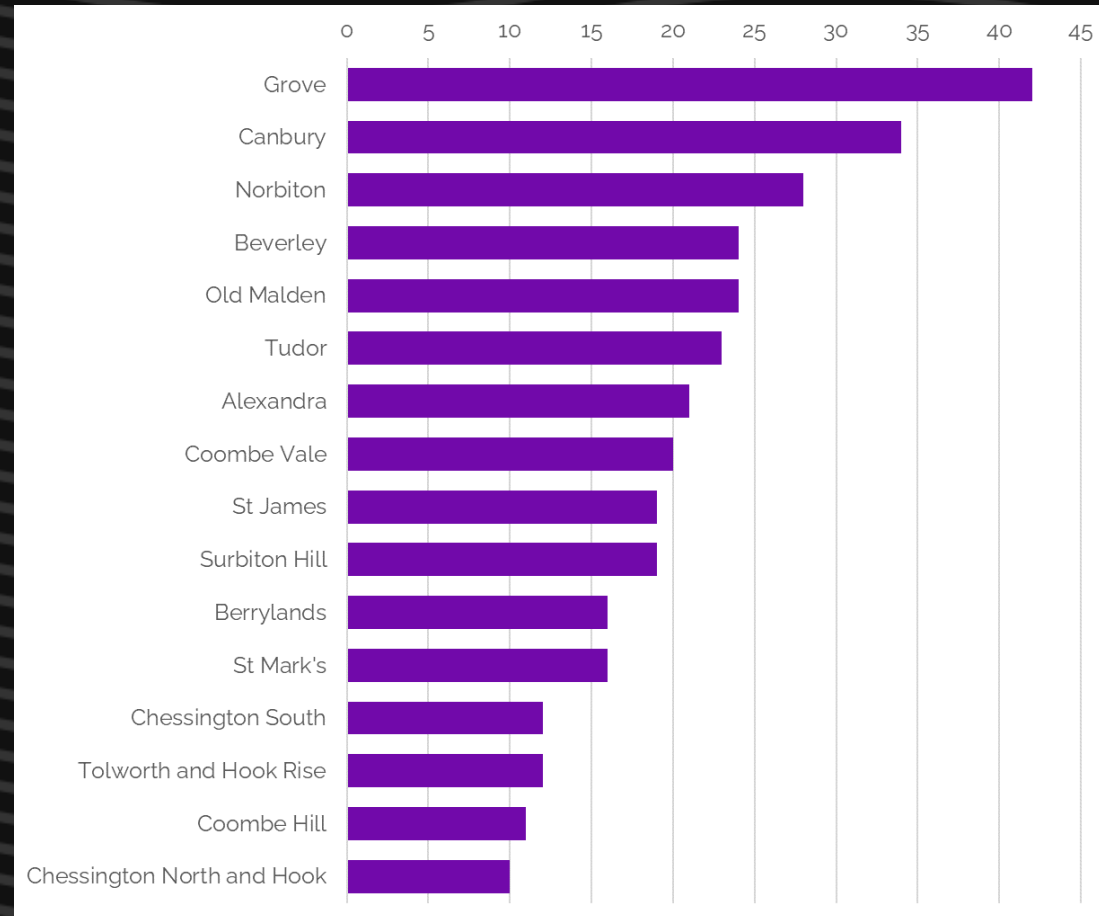

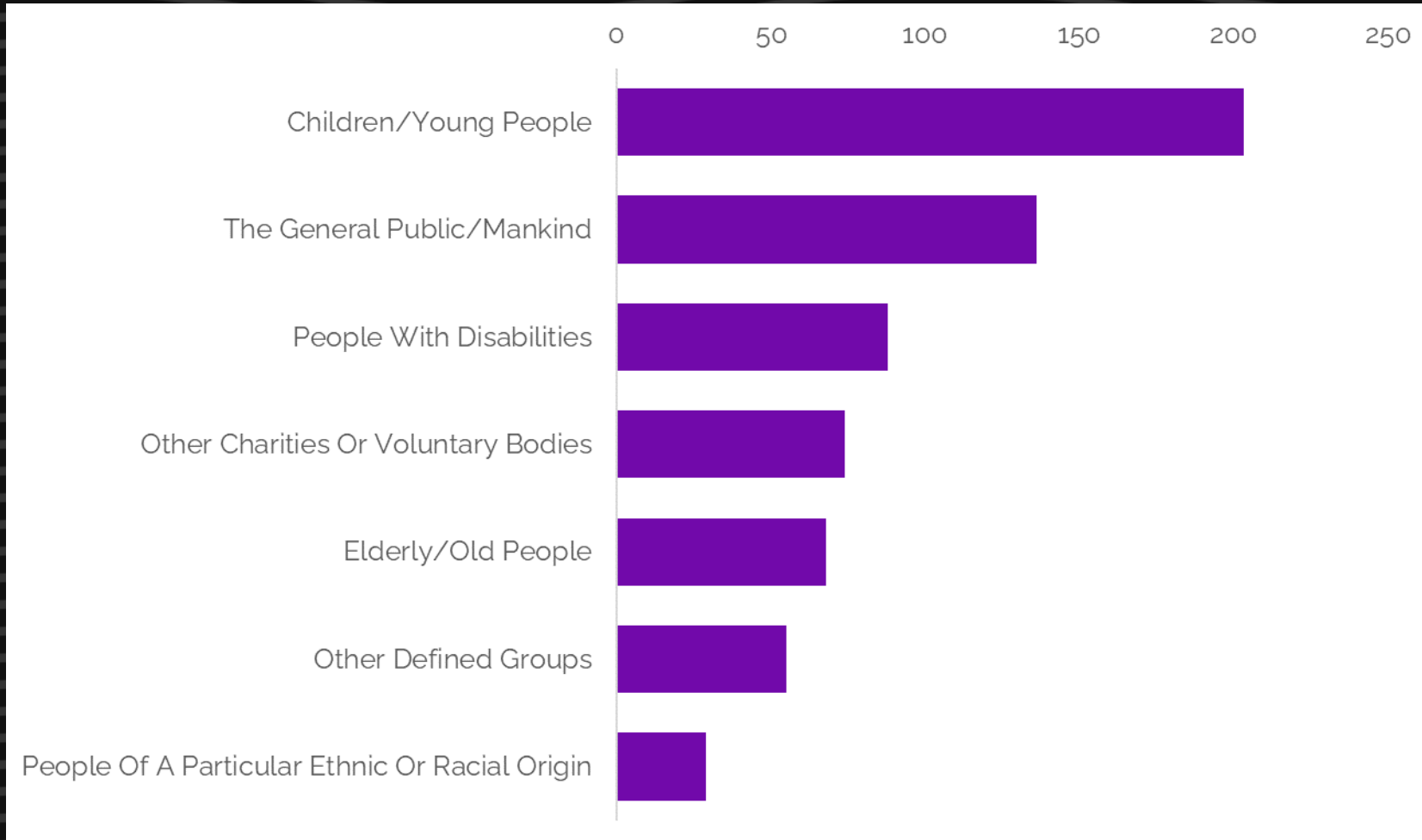
