

OSCI Local Insight and 2021 Census Data

What's the timeline for the remaining data release?

Between October and end of 2022. There are no specific deadlines as it takes some time to analyse.

How long does it take the new data to be available on Local Insight?

Three days to one week from publication.

Can you compare wards and areas within boroughs / local authorities?

Yes. Superhighways can import the ward boundaries you want to consider. You can also create boundaries that are unique to the specific geography you need.

You can also have groupings of local authorities e.g. Integrated Care Boards.

Flo will explore further whether the Boards cover whole boroughs and do not cross borough boundaries, as this is the case for some other areas in the UK.

Once the smaller area data (e.g. ward, super lower output area) has been released it will be possible to slice the data across varying geographies.

Can I upload my own postcode data?

Yes, you can plot your own postcodes as pins on a map of the indicators you are looking at.

You can also use Community Lens to compare your data to the Indices of Multiple Deprivation.
